- ➤ To increase the awareness amongst children the school organised few lectures. It is an attempt by the school to help student in getting clarity in their thought process.
- ➤ A session was organised on Cyber Safety and Security. The session was conducted for students of std. 8<sup>th</sup>. Dr. Deepti Lele, an expert consultant in Cyber Security made children aware of how to use cyber facilities wisely. She talked about the difference between real and virtual world and the basic checkpoints where they need to be sceptical about.

- ➤ IPC in daily life is conducted to make children aware of the laws and regulations in BHARTIYA DAND SANHITA, so that they can avoid unforeseen misbehaviour on their part.
- ➤ It is to make them aware that some casual actions can be considered as legal assaults and they need to be aware not to commit any. The session was conducted by Ms Chinmayee Khare who is an alumni of ILS law college.
- ➤ Career guidance sessions were conducted to introduce different career path to students, which can be chosen after tenth and also to let them know what efforts are needed to achieve them.
- > This year 2 career guidance sessions were conducted.
- ➢ First one was CAREERS in Social Service by Ms Sukhada Khisti. And the second session was about CAREERS IN 2030 BY Dr Shantanu Deshpande.
- ➤ Global Handwashing Day and National Cleanliness week was celebrated. The teachers briefed students about correct way to wash the hands and made them wash their hands before each meal.
- Swacchata Abhiyan was also celebrated, when children cleaned their classrooms and corridors and other rooms.
- ➤ Session was conducted for std 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> on **Dental Hygiene by Dr Karnik**. She gave information about the importance of

  Dental Health and how to use a Tooth Brush.
- ➤ **Dr Suneel Godbole** a well-known Paediatrician, conducted a session on Growing Up for 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Standard Boys and Our Counsellor Gauri Gharpure conducted the same for Girls.
- ➤ Study skills sessions were conducted for std. 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>. The session includes discussion about why studies are important, how planning and time management is helpful. How to use different study techniques for different subjects and lastly the concentration technique was taught to the children. They were assured that they can reach out to the counsellor if they have issues in studying and concentration.

- ➤ Life skill sessions were conducted for Std 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> once a month. The sessions were carried using discussion about various concepts like emotional awareness, empathy, labelling self and others, empathy in action, altruism etc.
- ➤ These are helpful to become self- aware and manage the behaviour better.
- Counselling is the main function of the counselling cell. One on one counselling was also given to the students as and when needed. Counselling sessions with parents were also conducted as and when needed so that they can also participate in the healing journey of their child.
- Session was conducted to create awareness about helpful parenting for Senior KG. This session was conducted by Mrs Suchitra Date, who is a renowned Psychologist and a classical Bharatnatyam dancer.
- ➤ Another session was conducted for the Parents of Mini KG, by Dr Sunil Godbole and Dr Ashwini Godbole.
- ➤ Kargil Vijay Diwas was celebrated by arranging an Audio-Visual show for the students and also to cultivate patriotism in children by knowing about the Kargil War.
- ➤ A session was organised by Damini Pathak. They guided our students regarding precautionary measures that needed to be taken by them to stay safe.
- ➤ A programme called JEEVIT NADI- The life of a River was conducted for creating Environmental Awareness Among Students. This was conducted for the students of 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.
- ➤ Another programme was conducted by Mr Amit Godbole and his team from MASTER CARE FOUNDATION called HAZARDS OF PLASTIC and it was conducted for the students of std 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>.
- ➤ Our school celebrated National Sports Day on 29<sup>th</sup> August that is on Dhyan Chands birthday to honour the hockey legend.
- ➤ Maharashtra Sports Day was celebrated on 15<sup>th</sup> of January.
- ➤ We took our students to Rajrohi and Parle Factory for school picnic.

- ➤ Science Day was celebrated with a session by Mr Amit Purandare from an Organisation called ASTRONOMICA. This session was conducted for the students of std 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.
  - ➤ To enhance the quality of education and professional development for Teachers and Students, the school organised workshop on Life Skills by experts to improve teaching methodologies, equip educators with new skills and foster student wellbeing.
