SI. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :		
1	The total number of sections of Bal The total number of sections of Bal Vatika shall be restricted to 3 (1 each for Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 12. The total number of sections taken together for classes XI and XII should not be more than 1/3 of the number of section allowed including Bal Vtika. Any further increase shall require prior permission of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with the affiliation Bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 sq ft dimensions.		
2	The CwSN toilets are not seen on every floor. Thus, the school is required to construct the CwSN toilets separately for boys and girls on each floor with sufficient space for easy movement of the wheelchair as well as handrail on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and Board's guidelines within 03 months and submit the compliance.		
3	Maths lab does not have appropriate workstation/demonstration tables. The workstation of Physics lab is placed on side slab which is not conducive for conductir experiments. Safety features like fire extinguisher and emergency exit are not seen in Composite lab and Chemistry lab. Biology lab does not have permanent workstations with appropriate fixture like sinks with water connection on the demonstration table.		

	Hence the school is directed to upgrade the labs as per Board's SoP and submit the compliance within 3 months.
4	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Pune within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/-every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

The school will follow syllabus and courses as per scheme of studies prescribed by the Board for Secondary/Sr. Secondary School Examination and changes made therein from time to time.
- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt from time to time.
- The school must follow Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI-IX from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards as per the Board's Circular No..: Acad-14/2017, dated 21.03.2017.
- 5. The school must submit it's information through online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per the Board's Circular No. CBSE/Aff./4/Circular/2016, dated 10.11.2016, within 30 days from the receipt of this grant letter. - 6. The school will enroll students proportionate to the facilities available in the school as prescribed in the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board which shall not in general exceed the optimum number as under:-

- (d) School running on bigger campus of more than 02 acres, the number of students shall be restricted as per the actual facilities in the school which shall be proportionate to the optimum number mentioned at (a), (b) and (c) above.
- (e) Schools running on less than 01 acre campus shall restrict number of students as follows:-

- 7. The school will provide well equipped Laboratories, Library and other facilities as per norms of the Board. The relevant books to the academic level of students to be made available in the library and would keep at least 05 books per student subject to a minimum of 1500 books excluding text books.
- 8. The school will also abide itself by the conditions of affiliation already prescribed by the State Government concerned.
- As per Affiliation Bye-laws the optimum strength of a section should not exceed more than 40 students.
- 10. School should have at least one adequately equipped computer lab with a minimum of 10 computers and would ensure computer student ratio of 1:20 at least. Proper software along with facility of Broad Band connectivity with the feature of 'internet always on' from any service provider to be ensured.
- 11. The section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provisions of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.

12. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.

13. The accounts should be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements should be prepared in the name of school, as per rules. A copy each of the Statements

of Accounts should be sent to the Board every year.

14. The school will strictly adhere with all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, school will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students.

- 15. Fees should normally be charged under the heads prescribed by the Department of Education of the State/U.T. for schools of different categories. No capitation fee or voluntary donations for gaining admission in the school or for any other purpose should be charged / collected in the name of the school and the school should not subject the child or his or her parents or guardians to any screening procedure in accordance with Rule No. 11.1, 2 & 3. Also, as per Chapter II, Rule No. 11.1 of Affiliation Bye-Laws, fees charges should be commensurate with the facilities provided by the institution.
- 16. The school should not use the activities for commercialization:-

a) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii) It shall ensure that the school is run as a community service and not as a business and that commercialization does not take place in the school in any shape whatsoever.

b) As per rule no. 19.1 (ii)a Any franchisee school making payment on account of use of name, motto and logo of franchiser institution or any other non-academic activities would be termed as commercialization of institution and to provide an affidavit that the school/society has not entered into any such contract to use Name, logo, motto for consideration of fee.

17. Teachers are to be made educated regarding corporal punishment& should avoid any type of such

involvement i.a.w. rule no. 44.1 (d & e).

18. School will not prepare any student/ start class for any other Board except CBSE from their CBSE affiliated school building/ premises.

19. Admission to the school is to be made restricted under rule 6.1 of Examination bye laws and rule 12 (i, ii & iii) of Affiliation bye laws.

- 20. The school has to constitute a committee for protection of woman from sexual harassment at the work place and to abide by the guidelines and norms prescribed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in W.P. Criminal No.666-70 of 1992 Vishaskha and other State of Rajasthan and other delivered on 13.8.1997 mentioned under rule no. 10.9.
- 21. Each school affiliated/ to be affiliated with the Board shall frame Service Rules for its employees which will be as per Education Act of the state/U.T., if the Act makes adoption of the same obligatory, otherwise as per Service Rules given in Affiliation Bye Laws. Further, Service contract will be entered with each employee as per the provisions in the Education Act of the state/ U.T., or as given in Appendix III, if not obligatory as per the State Education Act.

22. Pay and allowances to staff should be revised time to time to bring it at par with that to State Government. Further, Salary and service conditions of staff should be provided i.a.w. rule no. 3.3

(v) and rule no. 10.2 as appended below:-

a. The school in India must pay salaries and admissible allowances to the staff not less than the corresponding categories of employees in the State Government schools or as per scales etc. prescribed by the Government of India." Further, the service conditions as per Rule 10 and Rules 24 to 49 of Affiliation Bye-Laws also be adhered to.

b. Salary should be paid through Electronic Clearing Service (ECS) from the date of first

appointment of the teachers on probation.

23. As per Rule 13.3 and 13.3 (i), the school shall supply information and returns called for by the Board/State/ Central Government/Local Authority within the prescribed time given for its furnishing to the authority concerned and the school should prepare its annual report containing comprehensive information including name, address postal and e-mail, telephone numbers, affiliation status, period of provisional affiliation, details of infrastructures, details of teachers, number of students and status of fulfillment of norms of affiliation Bye-Laws and upload same on the website before 15th September of every year.

24. Continuous sponsoring of students at Board examination is to be made as per rule 13.12 (iv), Failure to do so will lead to suomoto withdrawal of the affiliation of the school for Secondary and Senior Secondary Examination as the case may be.

25. As per rule 13.12 (ii), no affiliated school shall endeavour to present the candidates who are not on its roll nor shall it present the candidates of its unaffiliated Branch/School to any of the Board's

Examinations.

- 26. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- 27. As per rule no. 8.2 and 13.11, facilities for physically challenged student should be adequately provided and every school shall promote inclusion of student with disabilities/special needs in the normal school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.

28. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped i.a.w. rule no. 3.3 (vii), rule 8.5

and rule 23.11.

29. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer scripts should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.

30. As per rule no. 8.8 (iv & v), every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address-postal and e-mail, telephone nos. etc.

31. As per rule no. 3.3 h (vi), every school should organize at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognized by the State or

Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.

32. Every secondary and senior secondary school shall appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of a Health Wellness teacher as per rule 53.5.

33. Strict adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for

the use in laboratories by the school must be made i.a.w. circular no 03 dated 21 May 2013.

34. As per rule 15.1 (d), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/ CBSE and text books publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to preclude any objectionable content that hurts the feelings of any class, community, gender, religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the written declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own the responsibility.

35. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 53.2.2(a) and 53.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class I to V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines

framed by the NCTE for the purpose.

36. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation/ Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites www.cbseaff.nic.in&www.cbse.nic.in for updates.

37. 5-6 names of persons not below the rank of Principal of Sr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended so that two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominee in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principal of KV/JNV.

38. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.

- 39. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
- 40. The Board would not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management/ Trust to another Society/Management/Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall no be closed down in the same premises. In case such transaction is effected explicitly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.

41. The school should not start Class XI/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class XI/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
