**ANNUAL REPORT**

**ACADEMIC YEAR APRIL 2024 TO MARCH 2025**

- The Academic year started on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2024.
- The total number of students is 1536 including pre-primary, primary and secondary section.
- The total number of teachers is 73 excluding Principal.
- Vidyavrat Sanskaar – Is a program presented by Jnana Prabodhini. All students from std. 8<sup>th</sup> took 'Oath of pursuing learning' which is called 'Vidyavrat Sanskar'. This was celebrated during 23<sup>rd</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> April. Various guest lectures were arranged to talk about the motivation and learning as well as to present the view of ideal student-hood. Hon. Principal Mrs. Jyoti Rokde and parents were also a part of the ceremony, happened on 27<sup>th</sup> April.
- Orientation session for std. 1<sup>st</sup> was conducted by the Vice Principal, Mrs. Suniti Joshi, on 20<sup>th</sup> April and for std. 2<sup>nd</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> were conducted by the respective class teachers on 6<sup>th</sup> April.
- Orientation session was conducted for Mini. KG on 15<sup>th</sup> of March, for Jr. K G and Sr. K G on 20<sup>th</sup> April, by the Vice Principal, Mrs. Suniti Joshi.
- Formulation of School Parent Teacher Association (PTA) by random selection of parent representatives was conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> April.
- Parent meeting for std. 5<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 10<sup>th</sup> April and for std. 10<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 15<sup>th</sup> June. Meetings of parents from std. 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> students were also conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> April. Also, some additional parent meetings were conducted as and when needed to guide parents on different issues / topics.
- 'National Reading Day', was observed by students and teachers by reading together for one period in the school, on 19<sup>th</sup> June.
- 'Yoga - Day' – International Yoga-day was celebrated on 21<sup>st</sup> June. Students presented 'Yogasanas' and 'Suryanamaskaras' under observation of yoga teacher in front of all the students from pre-primary to 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Book exhibitions were arranged on 1<sup>st</sup> August for std. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> and on 3<sup>rd</sup> August for std. 3<sup>rd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. The exhibition was arranged to help children to view, handle and purchase books of different genres.
- Head Boy, Head Girl and respective house captains were elected by conducting general elections in school. All students casted their votes on 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

- Blood testing camp was arranged for all the teachers on 5<sup>th</sup> of July.
- 'Palakhi' procession was organised by Pre-Primary section on 16<sup>th</sup> July to celebrate the famous occasion of 'Ashadh Ekadashi'. This is one of the iconic events celebrated all over Maharashtra every year.
- 'Investiture ceremony' for elected student representatives was conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> July on the auspicious occasion of Gurupournima celebrations at SEMS. The representatives were elected by computerized voting system.
- Film club activity was arranged during the period of 1<sup>st</sup> August for std. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in which films on 'National Integration' and environment were shown to the students.
- Pre-Primary Section celebrated 'Deepa Amavasya' by arranging different kinds of 'Diyas' (oil lamps traditionally used in India) and performing 'pooja' on 2<sup>nd</sup> August.
- Annual General Body Meeting was conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup> of August through online mode.
- 'Environmental Awareness' session for std. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 9<sup>th</sup> August on 'Hazards of Plastic' by the Mastercard initiative - MC Cares. The volunteers who are office bearers at Mastercard presented information to children and put out an exhibition and demonstration about the ill-effects of using plastic.
- 'Environmental Awareness' session for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 8<sup>th</sup> August by Jeevitnadi organization. Mrs. Aditi Deodhar and Mrs. Ashwini Bhilare who presented about why rivers are important and how we should keep them clean. They also told 'The story of a river'. Children made posters which were displayed for everyone for almost a week in the new assembly hall.
- Independence Day was celebrated jointly by Sevasadan English Medium school and Dilasa Karyashala. Principals of both the schools Mrs. Meghana Joshi (Dilasa Karyashala) and Mrs. Jyoti Rokde (SEMS) hoisted the flag, students sung national anthem and other national songs and some students gave speeches as well. Sweets were distributed after the program.
- Rakhi making activity was conducted during the period of 12<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> August for the children of secondary section
- Annual cultural competitions were conducted during 12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> of August for Primary and Secondary sections. Pre-primary section conducted the competitions on 4<sup>th</sup> & 5<sup>th</sup> September. All three sections conducted different competitions appropriate to the age and skills of the students. Some special mentions could be shloka chanting, solo presentations of poetry / drama, object talk, elocution etc. Parents were invited to judge the competition and distribute the certificates.
- On 27<sup>th</sup> August, the Pre-primary section celebrated Shri-Krishna Janmashtami by arranging 'Dahihandi'. Children enjoyed music, dance and 'Makhanchori' event.
- Eco-Friendly Ganapati Decoration activity was conducted for students of std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> during 26<sup>th</sup> August to 6<sup>th</sup> September. Children created and painted Ganesh idols and created eco-friendly decorative material.
- Parent Teacher Interactions (PTIs) were conducted on 4<sup>th</sup> September and 6<sup>th</sup> September, for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> and std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> respectively.

- Teachers' day was celebrated on 5<sup>th</sup> September where std. 10<sup>th</sup> students taught to the primary section students. All of them enjoyed the activity.
- Elementary and Intermediate exams were conducted from 25<sup>th</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> of September at our school centre.
- World of Puzzles and Brain Games – an exhibition was arranged in collaboration with the brand Smart Champs on 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of October for the students and parents of Mini. KG to 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Mathlete exam was conducted in school on 19<sup>th</sup> October.
- Olympiad exams were conducted at our school centre as follows – English Olympiad on 8<sup>th</sup> October, Science Olympiad on 18<sup>th</sup> October, Math Olympiad on 19<sup>th</sup> November and Cyber Olympiad on 21<sup>st</sup> January.
- 'Swacchata Abhiyaan' (Cleanliness drive) were celebrated for two weeks during 13<sup>th</sup> to 30<sup>th</sup> October.
- First Term end examinations were conducted for all sections during 30<sup>th</sup> September to 10<sup>th</sup> October.
- 'Bhondala' was celebrated on 11<sup>th</sup> of October by Pre-primary section to celebrate the cultural event of Navratri. ('Bhondala' is celebrated by dancing in a circle holding hands of each other while singing different traditional songs inherited to current generations. It is celebrated all over Maharashtra as is Garba in Gujarat.)
- 'Vachan Prerna Divas' was celebrated on October 15<sup>th</sup> on the occasion of birth anniversary of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam to promote reading not only as an activity but as a habit.
- Class photographs were clicked on 15<sup>th</sup> October.
- Fire drill was conducted with the students of std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> on 21<sup>st</sup> October. The preparatory instructions were given to the students and teachers beforehand and the paths for evacuation of the building are already marked for the same. The evacuation took place in approximately 10 minutes. Refinements in the evacuation plan and exit-routes will be made incorporating the experience of the drill, if required.
- Parent Teacher Interactions for std. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> November and for std. 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> were conducted on 23<sup>rd</sup> October and 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 24<sup>th</sup> October respectively. PTI for 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 7<sup>th</sup> of December.
- 'Pharaal' packets were distributed to children from primary and secondary section on 24<sup>th</sup> and Pre-Primary section had Diwali-Party on 25<sup>th</sup> October; children enjoyed it.
- Diwali Art and Craft competitions were conducted for primary section on 25<sup>th</sup> October.
- Annual Sports days were arranged on 21<sup>st</sup> November for Primary Section, on 4<sup>th</sup> December for Secondary section and on 29<sup>th</sup> November for Pre-primary section. Students showed their competence in games like foot cricket, hurdle race, running, relay and various other sports appropriate to their age groups. Best sportspersons from each of the sections were given a prize for appreciation.
- Pre- Primary section arranged Christmas party on 23<sup>rd</sup> December.
- Yearly picnic was arranged for all sections on the dates mentioned below :
