## **ANNUAL REPORT**

### **ACADEMIC YEAR APRIL 2023 TO MARCH 2024**

- The Academic year started on 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2023.
- The total number of students is 1504 including pre-primary, primary and secondary section.
- The total number of teachers is 69 excluding Principal.
- Vidyavrat Sanskaar – Is a program presented by Jnana Prabodhini. All students from std. 8<sup>th</sup> took 'Oath of pursuing learning' which is called 'Vidyavrat Sanskar'. This was celebrated during 11<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> April. Various guest lecture were arranged to talk about the motivation and learning as well as to present the view of ideal studenthood. Hon. Principal Mrs. Jyoti Rokde and parents were also a part of the ceremony, happened on 15<sup>th</sup> April.
- Orientation sessions for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> were conducted by the Vice Principal, Mrs. Suniti Rampure, on 18<sup>th</sup>, 19<sup>th</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> April respectively.
- Orientation session was conducted for Jr.K G on 25<sup>th</sup> April and for Sr. K G on 26<sup>th</sup> April, by the Vice Principal, Mrs. Suniti Rampure.
- Formulation of School Parent Teacher Association (PTA) by random selection of parent representatives was conducted on 20<sup>th</sup> April.
- Parent meeting for std. 5<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> June and for std. 10<sup>th</sup> was conducted on 17<sup>th</sup> June. Meetings of parents from std. 6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> students were also conducted during this period. Also some additional parent meetings were conducted as and when needed to guide parents on different issues / topics.

- 'National Reading Day', was observed by students and teachers by reading together for one period in the school, on 19<sup>th</sup> June.
- 'Yoga Day' – Yoga day was celebrated on 21<sup>st</sup> June. Students presented 'Yogasanas' and 'Suryanamaskaras' under observation of yoga teacher in front of all the students from pre-primary to 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Book stalls were arranged from 26<sup>th</sup> June to 1<sup>st</sup> July for Secondary section and 27<sup>th</sup> July to 4<sup>th</sup> of August for Primary section by the book company named 'Wordsmith'. This was conducted to help children to view, handle and purchase books of different genres.
- Head Boy, Head Girl and respective house captains were elected by conducting general elections in school. All students casted their votes on 28<sup>th</sup> June.
- 'Palakhi' procession was conducted by Pre-Primary section on 28<sup>th</sup> June to celebrate the famous occasion of 'Ashadh Ekadashi'. This is one of the iconic events celebrated all over Maharashtra every year.
- 'Investiture ceremony' for elected student representatives was conducted on 3<sup>rd</sup> of July on the auspicious occasion of Gurupournima. The representatives were elected by computerized voting system.
- Film club activity was arranged during the period of 4<sup>th</sup> July to 7<sup>th</sup> July, in which films on 'National Integration' were shown to the students.
- Pre-Primary Section celebrated 'Deepa Amavasya' by arranging different kinds of 'Diyas' (oil lamps traditionally used in India) and performing 'pooja' on 17<sup>th</sup> of July.
- 'Environmental Awareness' session was conducted on 26<sup>th</sup> July for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> by guest speaker Mr. Mohan Upadhye who talked about 'Turtle Conservation'. Similar session was arranged for std. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> on 4<sup>th</sup> of August; guest speaker Mr. Devendra Gogate talked about 'Tiger Conservation'.
- Annual General Meeting was conducted on 5<sup>th</sup> of August for parents of std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> students, zoom meeting room was made available for participation.
- Independence day was celebrated jointly by Sevasadan English Medium school and Dilasa Karyashala. Principals of both the schools Mrs. Meghana Joshi (Dilasa Karyashala) and Mrs. Jyoti Rokde (SEMS) hoisted the flag, students sung national anthem and other national songs and some students gave speeches as well. Sweets were distributed after the program.



- Annual cultural competitions were conducted during 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> of August. All three sections - Pre-primary, primary and secondary conducted different competitions appropriate to the age and skills of the students. Some special mentions could be shloka chanting, solo presentations of poetry / drama, object talk, elocution etc. Parents were invited to judge the competition and distribute the certificates.
- All sections arranged different programmes during 24<sup>th</sup> & 25<sup>th</sup> August to celebrate Nagapanchami. An Awareness towards Environment Programme was conducted by showing different films on snakes and overall environmental conservation.
- During 23<sup>rd</sup> August to 1<sup>st</sup> of September Art and Craft activities were conducted for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> to celebrate the occasion of Rakshabandhan.
- On 6<sup>th</sup> of September, the Pre-primary section celebrated Shri-Krishna Janmashtami by arranging 'Dahihandi'. Children enjoyed music, dance and 'makhanchori' event.
- Eco-Friendly Ganapati Decoration activity was conducted for students of std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> during 4<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> September. Children created and painted Ganesh idols and did drawing and painting as well.
- On 26<sup>th</sup> September, Parent Teacher Interactions (PTIs) were conducted for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>. For std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> and std. 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> PTIs were conducted on 27<sup>th</sup> September.
- English Olympiad was conducted on 26<sup>th</sup> September, Science Olympiad on 17<sup>th</sup> October, Math Olympiad on 31<sup>st</sup> October and Cyber Olympiad on 28<sup>th</sup> November.
- 'Swacchata Diwas' (Cleanliness drive) was celebrated by all sections on 3<sup>rd</sup> of October to celebrate Gandhi Jayanti.
- First Term end examinations were conducted for all sections during 6<sup>th</sup> October to 16<sup>th</sup> October.
- 'Bhondala' was celebrated on 18<sup>th</sup> of October by Pre-primary section to celebrate the cultural event of Navratri. ('Bhondala' is celebrated by dancing in a circle holding hands of each other while singing different traditional songs inherited to current generations. It is celebrated all over Maharashtra as is Garba in Gujarat.)
- 'Vachan Prerna Divas' was celebrated on October 18<sup>th</sup> to promote book reading on Dr APJ Abdul Kalam's birth anniversary.
- Class photographs were clicked on 20<sup>th</sup> October.
- English marathon exams were conducted on 21<sup>st</sup> October.
- 'Bharatiya Bhasha Utsav' was conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> of November for std. 4<sup>th</sup> where numbers and number names in different languages were introduced to children.

- Parent Teacher Interactions for std. 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> November and for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 4<sup>th</sup> November.
- Pre-Primary section had Diwali-Party on 7<sup>th</sup> November which was enjoyed by children.
- Diwali drawing competitions were conducted for primary section on 8<sup>th</sup> of November.
- Activity Display was conducted for secondary section on 2<sup>nd</sup> of December and on 6<sup>th</sup> of January for primary section.
- Pre- Primary section arranged Christmas party on 23<sup>rd</sup> December.
- Yearly picnic was arranged. Secondary section visited Science park and Lekha Farms on 3<sup>rd</sup> November with the students of std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> and on 1<sup>st</sup> of December with the students of std. 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>. Primary Section visited Kalpataru farms and Kundan handloom factory near 'Theur' on 22<sup>nd</sup> December. Pre-primary section visited Ghadage Farm on 8<sup>th</sup> December.
- Annual Sports days were arranged on 1<sup>st</sup> December for Primary Section, on 16<sup>th</sup> December for Secondary section and on 22<sup>nd</sup> December for Pre-primary section. Students showed their competence in games like foot cricket, hurdle race, running, relay and various other sports appropriate to their age groups. Best sportspersons from each of the sections were given a prize for appreciation.
- Parent Teacher Interactions for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 11<sup>th</sup> of January 2024.
- Prize distribution ceremony was conducted for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> on 17<sup>th</sup> January.
- Republic day was celebrated jointly by Sevasadan English Medium School and 'Dilasa Karyashala'. Students sang National Anthem and other patriotic songs as well as gave speeches on some famous personalities and their work, after flag hoisting.
- In the Cultural Carnival, students presented their talent in cultural activities. The presentations by students were carried out from 30<sup>th</sup> January to 2<sup>nd</sup> February by students of secondary section, std. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>, std. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> and students of Pre-primary section respectively on each day.



- Send off farewell party was arranged on 10<sup>th</sup> February for students of std. 10<sup>th</sup> in which principal Mrs. Jyoti Rokde guided students for future life and expressed her best wishes on behalf of school. Also, certificates for their academic and behavioural achievements were given away. Students expressed their gratitude and feelings towards school in their speeches. The program ended with a feast for all.
- Parent Teacher Interactions for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> were conducted on 14<sup>th</sup> February and for std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 4<sup>th</sup> on 15<sup>th</sup> February.
- Final Exams of std. 9<sup>th</sup> were conducted during 21<sup>st</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> February. Final Exams of std. 1<sup>st</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> were conducted from 4<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> March; along with the evaluation of students of the Pre-primary section.
- Spring break was given to students of std. 9<sup>th</sup> from 2<sup>nd</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> March and the extra classes were conducted from 13<sup>th</sup> to 29<sup>th</sup> March.
- Spring break for Std. Mini. K G to 8<sup>th</sup> was given from 13<sup>th</sup> March to 31<sup>st</sup> March. The results were declared on 27<sup>th</sup> March for the pre-primary section, 28<sup>th</sup> March for Primary section and 29<sup>th</sup> March for std. 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.
